Partnership News

Priest in charge advert

Good news. The advert for a permanent full time Priest in Charge is still live, but we have had 5 enquiries. Bishop Alan of Buckingham is leading this interview process and will be following the legal requirements. At the moment his PA, Catherine, is tracing the patrons of St Andrew's and St Mary Magdalene, to see if they are still wanting to be Patrons, and therefore involved in the appointment. It will be September before this is sorted and shortlisting will take place on 5th September (5.00pm – 6.00pm, to be held via Zoom), with interviews to follow on 6th October, held locally in MK.

Baptist Minister Post

The Trustees have agreed the paperwork needed to advertise the Baptist Minister post, as well as Lisa Kerry, the Regional Baptist Leader. The advert will be on our website and Facebook page very soon, so please spread the word.

Methodist ministry

We said good bye and thank you to Rev Nicola at her last service at St James in New Bradwell. We are having a plaque made to put on a bench she and Carol can sit on in their garden now they have moved to Cornwall.

Edson Dube, will be our Methodist Superintendent and he presented Rev Nicola with her gift at her service last week. He has said he will help whenever we need him and be there as a Mentor to Dave Haseldine when he joins us in September.

He will work 2 days a month for the SEP, which is half a day less than Nicola did. There will be a service to welcome him on 20th August at Newport Pagnell Methodist Church.

General Synod carries Oxford motion on the climate emergency

The Oxford Diocesan Synod motion, Responding to the Climate Emergency, has been overwhelmingly supported by General Synod. The motion calls for the National Investment Bodies of the Church of England to scale up investment in renewable energy and other environmental solutions and asks the Government to review planning regulations to aid the installation of renewable technology on church buildings.

Green Champions – Eco Tip

Have you heard about refill shops? A refill shop, or zero waste shop, gives you the option to use less packaging when you buy. These outlets reduce the amount of plastic that ends up in household waste. You take along your empty containers (bottles, boxes etc.), weigh them in store and then fill them from the large containers. Re-weigh and the cashier will calculate the prices of what you have bought. You can expect to find:

- Cupboard staples pasta, rice, oats, lentils, nuts, seeds, grains, cereals, spices and oils
- Dried fruits dates, dried apricots, figs, banana chips and coconut chips
- Cleaning products laundry detergent, washing up liquid and bathroom cleaner
- Toiletries toothpaste, soap, shower gel and shampoo
