Did you know that during 1 week last year, the UK threw away 2 billion pieces of plastic, only 12% of which was recycled? The Big Plastic Count is a nationwide initiative to reveal how much plastic the UK throws away. You can play your part by monitoring your rubbish and completing a chart. The results will be used to convince UK government ministers to lead the way at the Global Plastics Treaty talks in 2024, and push for a really strong treaty.

Taking part in The Big Plastic Count is really easy. Here's what you need to do:

- 1. **Register**: Get your free counting pack (digital or via post) which includes everything you need to take part
- 2. **Get Counting:** Count all your plastic waste from 11-17 March.
