## Reflection by John

Luke's narrative of the Emmaus Road is great 'theatre'! Here is a scenario wherein everyone [including us] knows just who the stranger is. Everyone, that is, except the two apostles who meet him. Then, with double irony, the stranger himself pretends to be ignorant of the very circumstances of his own death! So, the two travellers fail to recognise the stranger, even when Jesus talks about himself. [If this was a play by Agatha Christie, or even a pantomime, we would all be on the edge of our seats shouting, 'it's Jesus. It's Jesus. Look again.'] We each walk our own Emmaus Road. We too can fail to recognise Jesus when we meet him. If we would have it otherwise, we must look for him, with an open mind and our understanding informed.

### CHRISTIAN SOLIDARITY WORLDWIDE from Beryl

Pastor Lorenzo of Cuba was violently arrested in July 2021 while peacefully protesting. CSW have documented evidence and raised his case with experts at the UN who have now said his arrest contravenes nine different Articles of the UN Declaration of Human Rights. This confirms that there was no justifiable basis for his arrest, and Pastor Lorenzo should not be in prison. This is a significant breakthrough. The UN is also calling for reparations to be made and a full investigation into his unjust detention. Let us give thanks for the progress in Pastor Lorenzo's case and that the Cuban government put the recommendations of the UN Working Group into action – releasing Pastor Lorenzo immediately and unconditionally.
