Mexico: Father Marcelo Pérez was shot to death on 20th October. after he had officiated Mass in the city of San Cristóbal. Father Pérez is believed to have been targeted by transnational organised criminal groups, because he has called for an end to violence and corruption. In September 2024, he led a public march calling for peace in the region and spoke out against the growing presence of organised crime in Chiapas.
