UPDATE FROM THE HOOKE HERITAGE PROJECT

The St Mary Magdalene Willen Hooke Heritage project was created to repair and preserve its Grade 1 listed church and provide it with toilet, servery and meeting facilities (it currently has none of these). The project reports to the Stantonbury Ecumenical Partnership Council and is being delivered by a very small group from St Mary Magdalene Church and the wider community.

With a feasibility study now completed and with the Diocese of Oxford, Historic England and MK City Council providing encouragement in principle to proceed, preparation is now in hand to deliver ambitious, creative and engaging activities to further inform the church's planning.
