Reflection

Today's theme is divine 'calling' or 'vocation'. We hear two contrasting calls to discipleship. Firstly, the ancient prophet Isaiah experiences an amazing vision of the Lord God enthroned in heavenly glory, surrounded by worshipping angels. God's call, 'Whom shall I send and who will go for us?' - prompts Isaiah's immediate response, 'Here am I; send me!' The second divine call is very different, involving four 1st century Galilean fishermen: a humble, earthly scene. Jesus, God incarnate, has come to enable people to turn back to God, through repentance and trust. Simon Peter voices a human recognition of unworthiness and sinfulness. But Jesus' authority and miraculous action cause the fishermen to leave everything and follow him. We, in turn, are called to follow; sent out into the world to call others, each in our own unique vocations. God bless, Helen

Cuba Wonderful news: Pastor Lorenzo has been released! On Friday 17 January at 8am, the Cuban pastor was met at the prison gates by his wife Maridilegnis, son David and daughter Lorena. This was the family reunion they had been waiting for since 11 July 2021, when Pastor Lorenzo Rosales Fajardo was unjustly arrested for peacefully protesting. That's 1,286 days of prayer, campaigning and advocacy by CSW and many others. Please pray that this freedom will be permanent and unconditional - that there will be no cruel twists to this happy news. Pastor Lorenzo was chosen to be one of 553 political prisoners freed as part of negotiations with the Vatican and the administration of US President Biden.
