This week in times past

1774 AD Boston Tea Party. A minor little known outside event America. In response to the Tea Act of 1773 British-Americans organised the destruction of an entire tea shipment from the East India Company. The Tea Act of 1773 actually lowered taxes on however the new bill threatened to put smugglers out of business. Ships had just arrived in Boston harbour, and were carrying imported tea free of tax. smugglers Roughly 80 protesters, some of whom were disguised as Native Americans, boarded the vessels during the night and dumped tea into the harbour. Of little significance at the time, it did not aquire it's name and fame in American history until the mid nineteenth century.

CHRISTIAN SOLIDARITY WORLDWIDE from Beryl

Iran, Please pray for an Armenian prisoner of conscience, Hakob Gochumiyan. He is currently serving a 10-year sentence in Iran but shouldn't be in prison at all. CSW are trying to ensure high-level interventions on his behalf to secure his release. He was arrested during a family visit to Iran and placed in solitary confinement. CSW have received a letter from him. 'I am Hakob, a citizen of Armenia. Since 15 August 2023, I have been in an Iranian prison for my faith for the unfounded reason of preaching and teaching Christianity. I was later sentenced to 10 years of imprisonment. The investigation by the Iranian Ministry of Intelligence was carried out with gross violations of human rights.' Pray for Hakob's safety and for his immediate, unconditional release.
