# Eco Tip for May 2025

As summer approaches and with the unpredictable nature of our weather, it is a good time to consider how we can reduce our water usage and save money too.

Here are some tips:

- Don't leave the tap running when cleaning your teeth. If rinsing vegetables, dishes etc., use a bowl of water instead and use it afterwards to water your plants.
- Have fewer baths, which can use up to 80 litres of water. Shower instead and restrict the time you spend in there to 4 minutes. You can get more efficient shower heads and fix aerators, to shower heads and taps, which add air to the water so reducing water usage.
- Dual flush toilets are common these days but if you don't have one you can put a water displacement device in the cistern or reduce flushing – `if it's yellow let it mellow'!
- Only wash full loads in dishwashers and washing machines.
- In the garden install a water barrel to collect rainwater to water plants. Water in the morning or evening to reduce evaporation and also use grey water.
