Eco Tip for June 2025



Thursday 5th June is World Environment Day, which this year takes as its theme "Ending Plastic Pollution"

Key facts

- An estimated 583 billion plastic bottles were produced in 2021. That is 100 billion more than were produced just five years ago.
- In the UK it is estimated that five million tonnes of plastic is used every year, nearly half of which is packaging.
- Every minute, two garbage trucks of plastic are dumped into our oceans. Currently, a total of 8 million metric tons is dumped.
- Over 1 million marine organisms are killed each year due to plastic pollution in the ocean.

How you can help

- 1) Buy bags and other items, e.g. wipes, that are biodegradable or reuse them whenever possible.
- 2) Choose fruit and vegetables with paper or less packaging or take your own bag.
- 3) Study MK's recycling scheme. You can recycle plastic bottles, food trays, yoghurt and snack pots, cartons and tubs.
- 4) Share your ideas with your family, friends and members of your church and work together.
