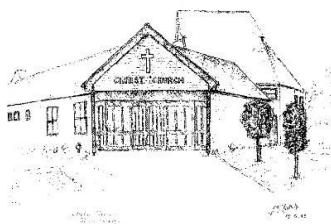

Eco Tip for January 2026

The Eco Tip to measure your carbon footprint at the beginning of the New Year is taken from the A Rocha November newsletter 2025 and contains two useful sites to guide you doing this.

Eco tip: Measure your carbon footprint.

Take an audit of your individual or household carbon footprint, then repeat this each year to see if you can reduce it! There are some great tools to help you, including the carbon calculators provided by Climate Stewards at climatestewards.org/carbon-calculators. There are lots of ways to reduce your footprint, from switching energy suppliers to changing your diet.

Creation Care, at creationcare.org.uk, has resources specifically for households that give you ideas and help you track your progress. As you look at different areas of your life, consider lifting up each area or action to God as an offering.

Collection for the Food Bank.

In response to a specific request from Food Bank, during any given month we will endeavour to collect certain items rather than just lots of different things (Food Bank get given lots of baked beans – for instance). So, for November and December, can I suggest that you would consider donating **long life milk, squashes, fruit juice, Spreads, Jam, Peanut butter etc.**

All the years we have supported Food Cupboard and now Food Bank, members of Christ Church have been very generous. Please do not feel you have to do this but it is part of our community outreach as a church.
