Seminar on September 2nd. The Four Notes of The Church

On September 2nd, following Holy Communion at 10.00 am and a short break for fellowship, the third seminar in the present series will look at 'What happened to the concept of "One...Church"'?

The significant historical steps we shall explore briefly include the Ecclesia, the Emperor-Church interface, the move from Rome to Constantinople, the iconoclast controversy, the birth of 'The Holy Roman Empire', the *Filioque* controversy, the Great Forgery, the impact of the Reformation, and the growth of non-conformism.

Does the credal claim refer to a church that already exists or simply to a fervent hope?
